Formatting:

Font:

•Use Times New Roman, font size "12" throughout the paper (including the *Title Page* and

Reference Page)

**Margins** 

•Under Page Setup in your word processor (open File menu in Microsoft Word), set all 4

margins (top, bottom, and both sides) for 1"

•Your document should be one-sided, left justified, and double spaced throughout it's entirety

**Length of Paper:**•Your paper must stay within the guidelines of 4-5 pages in overall length

•The rough draft is not part of the paper, but it should be appended as a separate document for

myself or your peers to review

**References:** 

•This research paper is a referenced document, and you must find a minimum of 4-5 quality

sources to cite
